The Disability Resource Library (DRL) is located in the Center for Disabilities and Development. DRL has helpful items for people of all ages with disabilities. The library also has useful information and materials for families and health care workers.

DRL has information for, by, and about people with all kinds of disabilities. DRL has many items available to help with daily living and learning. Some of these are books, DVDs, computer programs, electronics, and physical aids. There are also books and DVDs in Spanish.

Besides lending items for home use, our skilled staff can help you:

Sometimes an item you want is checked out to someone else. If that happens, we will let you know when it is returned. You may also ask for materials to use at a future date. We will send them to you on the date you requested.

Prescription to Play The Prescription to Play program lends fun and helpful games, books, toys, and equipment to families being seen at the Center for Disabilities and Development. This program is great for children ages 3 to 12. Children getting care in any of our clinics will have the chance to work on their skills at home. It also helps parents join in their child's journey. These items are chosen by staff to help growth and development, such as:



- Communication
- Dramatic play
- Sensory Input
- Social skills
- Fine and gross motor skills
