

Notes of interest:

- <u>Parking</u>: It may be difficult for visitors to find parking spaces when the Iowa Legislature is in session so please allow extra time to locate parking.
- <u>Capitol Entrances:</u> Public entrances are located on the ground floor of the Iowa State Capitol on the south and west sides of the building.
 - o Upon entrance into the building, the public will walk through a security scan.
- <u>Lactation Room</u> The lactation room available for use in the Capitol is equipped with a chair, sink, and a surface for equipment and education materials. The Capitol lactation room is located in the ground floor Women's restroom located by the west ground floor entrance security checkpoint. If you are here for the day, you can use the room at an available time and the schedule is posted outside of the room. The room is reserved for 30 minute increments and may be accessed by a key maintained at the tour guide station located on the ground floor of the Capitol. Return the key to that location after you have used the room.
